About the Maurice Erly Professional Development Award

Maurice Erly retired from the Prince George's County Board of Education after 38 years of service with over 25 of those years spent as the Coordinating Supervisor of Staff Development. Maurice was passionate about education and professional development. He was always interested in learning about people and their expertise.

For over 44 years, Maurice served on the Educational Systems Federal Credit Union Board of Directors, with 25 of those years as Treasurer. Educational Systems FCU is proud to preserve Maurice's legacy by awarding professional development awards to educators who have made a difference by positively impacting student success and who inspire them to further their own development.

Twelve, \$1,000 Maurice Erly Professional Development Awards will be presented to educators to use towards continuing education fees, such as workshop registrations, certification fees and tuition.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this award, the educator must be employed by one of the three community colleges or eight counties we serve. In addition, one award will be presented to an educator who is employed outside of the counties we serve.¹ Educational Systems FCU or Support Education Foundation membership is required prior to application submission.² Educational Systems FCU employees, volunteers and their family members are not eligible to apply.

Application packages that are incomplete, emailed or postmarked after April 1, 2020 will not be considered.

Essay must be typed, Times New Roman, 12 pt, double spaced, with one inch margins. Essay must be between 250-500 words. Submit your essay as a PDF document without your name listed on the document.
